Part Four

Implement your design

The final part of this project requires you to implement your design, using semantic XHTML and CSS using the techniques shown in the ITB lectures.

Your final implementation should contain 5-10 pages (you are not expected to redesign a whole site – this can be regarded as a prototype design which indicates the design that would be used across the whole site). Pages are expected to be appropriate, both to the site and according to the techniques taught in ITB.

Sites should be constructed

- With appropriate valid semantic HTML
- Using CSS for design
- With any tools you like, but watch out for tools that don't generate correct semantic HTML or separate CSS files

Resources

Look for sites that can offer CSS column layout templates, or reuse markup/code from the lecture/labs.

You can use CSS from other sites, but it is very important to ensure that in the write up you indicate material that is sourced from other places. This should be referenced properly.

What to include in your writeup

In your Word document create a section called *Implementation* and write about how the site was created.

Then explain the actual design – use screenshots, HTML and CSS code to enhance the discussion. ALL markup and CSS files should be included in the document.

Finally include a Conclusion and Reflection on what you have learned, how it went and what you would do differently if you were to do it again.
