

XHTML Lab test assignment

In the week beginning 8th October you will have your first Lab based test on XHTML and web publishing. This test is open book, which means that you may bring and use any material you need. It will last for 60 minutes. All work must be completed in this time.

A description of what you are required to do is given below. It may also be worthwhile examining the checklist to satisfy yourself that you have covered the skills and knowledge that will be assessed in the test.

Standard University exam regulations will apply.

What you are required to do

You will have to create 2 web pages, which will contain text, images and links. You will be given instructions that will take you through these stages:

Stage 1 – creating the first page

The first page will contain text, XHTML and a link to an external site.

Stage 2 – creating the second page

The second page will contain text, XHTML, an image and a link to the first page you created.

You will submit the coursework by WRITING the markup on a piece of paper that will be handed in at the end of the test. Any work NOT written down will NOT count or be marked.

Checklist

Staff will NOT be able to help you with these tasks during the test – you MUST have mastered them before the lab.

Creating basic web pages

- I can use a text editor to create an XHTML template with appropriate `<html>`, `<head>` and `<body>` tags
- I can use `<title>` tags
- I can use `<p>` tags
- I can use `<h1>` `<h2>` `<h3>` `` `` tags
- I can create a link to a remote website using `` tags
- I can create a bullet point lists using tags

Using more sophisticated markup

- I can include an image using `` tags
- I can create a link to another page using `<a>` tags
- I can create a table with a heading row
